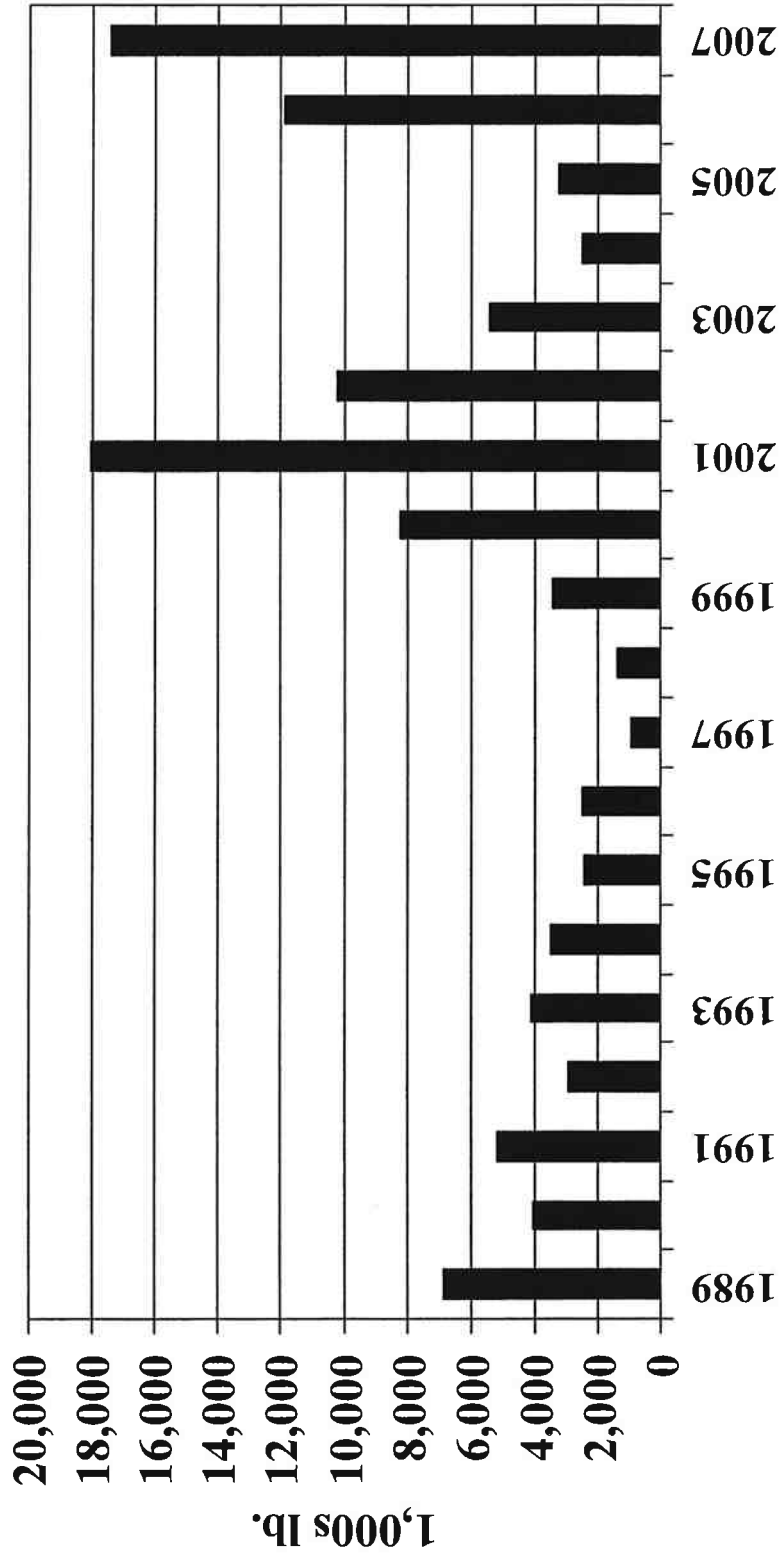


# U.S. Imports\* of Catfish
